## How-To Add Your Bellagio Network Affiliation to LinkedIn



## Step 1: Add "Bellagio Center Alumni" to the Experience section of your profile with the provided graphic


 The 'Experience' section lists your professional roles. Scroll down to this section of your profile and click the + button (see below).




- Type in the following responses to the fields. The asterisk (\*) denotes required fields.
  - o Title\*: Bellagio Center Alumni
  - Employment type: [not required]
  - Company name\*: The Rockefeller Foundation
    - Note: Start typing the name and select from the dropdown options.
  - Location: Bellagio, Lombardy, Italy
    - Note: Start typing "Bellagio" and select from the dropdown options.
  - Location type: [not required]



 Add your program's Start and End dates. In the Description field, you may include a description of your residency or convening.



• Scroll down to the **Media** section of the form. Select + **Add media**.




- Select the provided Bellagio Center Alumni icon file and upload.

- The experience will display like this:




## Step 2: Add the Bellagio Center Alumni background image to your profile
